Car Accident **\$2,000,000**

In this case we represented a 50-year-old Queens resident who was a passenger in a car that was hit on the front driver side. The collision was severe and caused serious injuries to her neck and right shoulder. As her condition worsened our client ultimately needed to undergo invasive surgery consisting of neck surgery and surgical repair of a tear in her right shoulder.

After this injury our client became disabled and eventually ended up needing to retire far earlier than she ever expected.

Because the defense initially refused to offer a fair settlement for our client's serious injuries, we pushed forward with a lengthy litigation. Our persistence paid off; faced with the pressure of a trial, the defendants finally agreed to a significant settlement that fully compensated our client.

Truck Accident **\$1,500,000**

We represented a young female driver who was stopped in traffic when a truck backed into her vehicle. The impact caused her body to jerk causing painful whiplash.

Following the accident, she underwent a course of therapeutic treatment, including injections to her neck and back. Unfortunately, these conservative treatments provided only temporary relief. As her symptoms persisted, she ultimately required significant surgical intervention.

We were successful in negotiating a favorable settlement for our client in the amount of \$1,500,000.

Pedestrian Accident

\$2,000,000

We represented a 65-year-old man who immigrated to the United States several years ago. Unfortunately, he was struck by a vehicle while walking within a pedestrian crosswalk in a Queens roadway, resulting in serious injuries to his neck, low back, and right shoulder.

Ultimately, despite engaging conservative care for several years, his doctors performed invasive neck and back surgery, and a repair of a tear to his right shoulder.

Despite our client's significant injuries, the Defendants refused to adequately compensate him until the eve of trial. We worked hard to prepare the client for success fighting for justice in Court. Under the pressure of a looming judgment, the defendants settled the case for an amount that fully and fairly compensated our client.

Trip and Fall Accident

\$575,000

Our 67-year-old client was returning to her apartment building when she tripped and fell on a raised, poorly maintained sidewalk. Due to the property owner's failure to maintain the premises in a reasonably safe condition, she sustained fractures to her right shoulder and arm. Her injuries required surgery and extensive physical therapy. After thorough negotiations and mediation, we successfully secured a favorable \$575,000 settlement on her behalf.

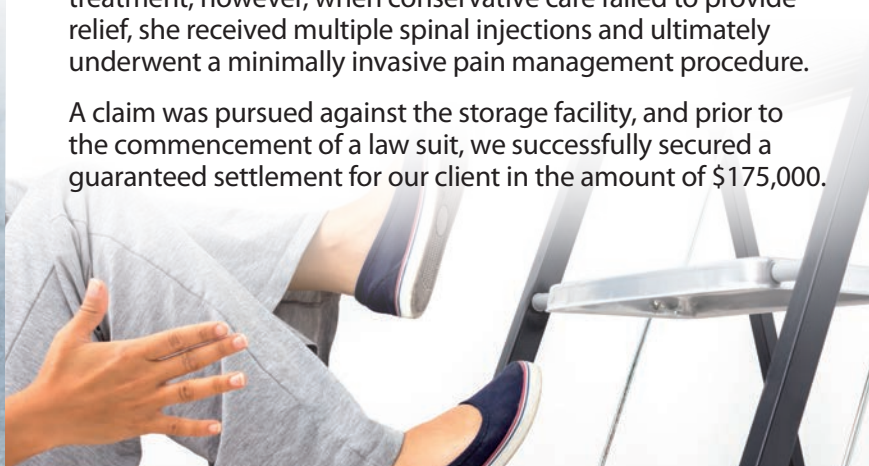
Fall-Down Accident

\$175,000

In November 2024, our client was retrieving personal belongings from her storage unit in Queens. Certain items were stored on an elevated shelf, requiring the use of a ladder provided by the storage facility. As our client descended the ladder after retrieving her belongings, the ladder shifted due to a defective mechanism, causing her to fall.

As a result of the fall, our client sustained injuries to her back. She initially underwent a course of conservative therapeutic treatment; however, when conservative care failed to provide relief, she received multiple spinal injections and ultimately underwent a minimally invasive pain management procedure.

A claim was pursued against the storage facility, and prior to the commencement of a law suit, we successfully secured a guaranteed settlement for our client in the amount of \$175,000.

Every Auto policy should include **Uninsured/Underinsured Motorist Coverage**

It is important to make sure you have sufficient auto insurance protection. You do not want to find out after an accident that you are not covered. Purchase Uninsured/ Supplemental Underinsured Motorist coverage (UM/SUM). This coverage is relatively inexpensive, and every driver should have it.

Never sign UM/SUM waivers.

UM coverage protects you in a hit-and-run accident or when a negligent driver in an automobile accident has no insurance. It pays you compensation for pain and suffering and economic loss.

SUM coverage safeguards you if you are injured by a careless driver who has only the minimal amount of insurance coverage. However, your SUM coverage limits must be higher than the coverage limits available in the defendant's liability insurance policy. For example, if the defendant in your case carries a liability policy in the amount of \$25,000 and your Supplemental Underinsured Motorist benefits are \$100,000, we may be able to first obtain the \$25,000 for you from the defendant and then collect additional compensation for you, up

to \$75,000 (\$100,000 SUM limits minus \$25,000 already obtained) from your Sum policy.

Protect yourself Be sure you have sufficient auto coverage for every driver in the family. Talk to your auto insurance agent to learn the extent that your UM/SUM coverage will safeguard you and your family. If the coverage is inadequate, increase your coverage. It is typically a minimal cost and worth the protection.
